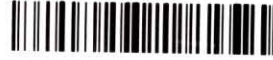

 - The date and time of stopping the drug along with the doctors name and sign must be mentioned.
 - Only one chart should be in use at any one time. When the chart is full, a new supplement can be kept within this drug sheet folder.
